Ppnr	Individual identifier
session	Session identifier
matchGroup	Identifier of the matching group
Period	Period (1 – 25)
treatment	Treatment variable: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- EndoA: Default is A, group entry endogenous- EndoB: Default is B, group entry endogenous- GroupA: Default is A, exogenous groups- GroupB: Default is B, exogenous groups- INDex: Exogenous individual decision making
Type	= treatment, unless treatment=EndoA or treatment=EndoB. In these cases, ‘Type’ gives the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- EndoAGroup: Default is A, individual entered group- EndoBGroup: Default is B, individual entered group- EndoInd: Individual chose individual decision making
Group	Indicator of whether decision is individual (0) or in group (1)
ADefault	Indicator of whether the default is A (1) or B (0)
Endo	Indicator of whether group entry endogenous (1) or exogenous (0)
part2	Indicator of whether decision was part of part 2 (period>9)
groupID	ID of group that an individual is part of for a decision
decision	Decision A (1) or B (0)
decisionEndoIndividual	Decision if decision is individual in periods with endogenous group entry (A or B)
decisionEndoGroup	Decision if decision is in group in periods with endogenous group entry (A or B)
select	Selection decision into individual (0) or group (1) decision making in periods with endogenous group entry
Belief	Belief about how many would choose A (1 – 10)
selfish	Indicator of whether individual is characterized as selfish (1) or not (0)
switch	Indicator of whether individual is characterized as switching (1) or not (0)

prosocial	Indicator of whether individual is characterized as prosocial (1) or not (0)
elicitation1	Belief of how many out of ten other subjects choose A if the default is A and decisions are made in endogenous groups
elicitation2	Belief of how many out of ten other subjects choose A if the default is A and decisions are made when opting for individual decision making
elicitation3	Belief of how many out of ten other subjects choose A if the default is B and decisions are made in endogenous groups
elicitation4	Belief of how many out of ten other subjects choose A if the default is B and decisions are made when opting for individual decision making
