

## Verb forms in German Sign Language

This gallery includes pictures of all verb forms included in the data set on which the study “Recurring iconic mapping patterns within and across verb types in German Sign Language” is based. Because the video stills come from natural conversations, some verb form tokens in this gallery represent forms that are modified to express agreement. TEACH, for instance, is modified to express third-person subject agreement and first-person object agreement.

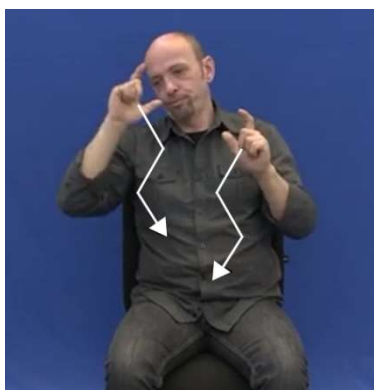

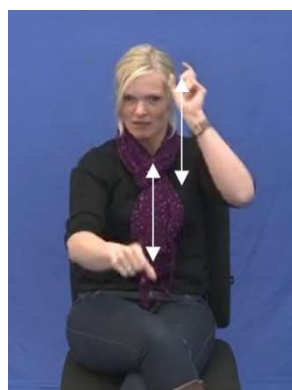
